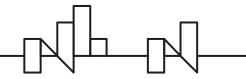

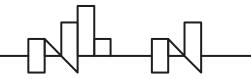
Polish Maritime Cluster main projects in the polish maritime industry

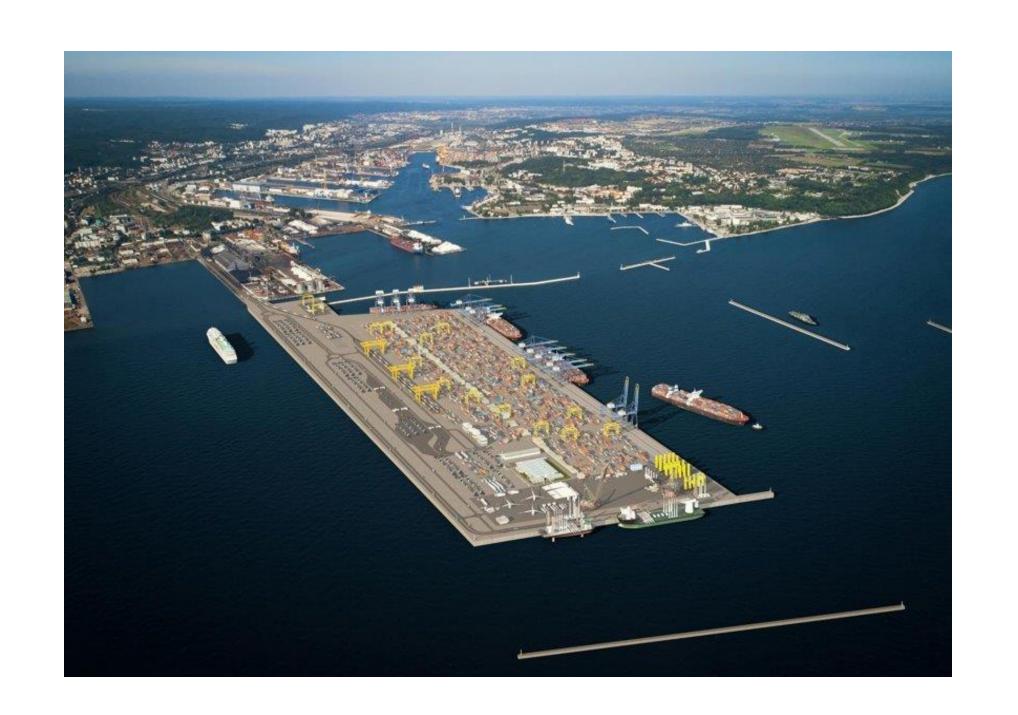


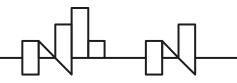


Gdynia Outer Port

The capacity of the terminal, according to initial assumptions, may amount to as much as 2.5 million TEU



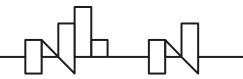

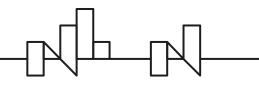
